12. **Malvasia Castelnuovo Don Bosco "Annalisa" DOC 2014** **\$38.00**  
 An enduring sweet smelling fragrance, sweet with a gentle sparkle, and is particularly suited as a dessert wine and with chocolate.

101. **Inama "Du Lot" Soave Classico 2013** **\$68.00**  
 100% Garganega grapes. Single-vineyard. Late harvest, 30% new barrique,

then 6 months in stainless steel vats. Powerful nose with hints of honey, chamomile, elder flowers iris.

- 102. Soave Classico Monte Tondo 2013** **\$38.00**  
Lovely aromas of fresh green apples, grapefruit and peaches. A full bodied, rich wine with intense fruit and long finish.
- 103. Di Lenardo Chardonnay "Father's Eyes" 2013** **\$38.00**  
A barrel aged Chardonnay that is particularly spicy and aromatic. The name says it all!
- 104. Chardonnay Kaltern Wadleith, Alto Adige 2013** **\$38.00**  
This buttery Chardonnay has great structure and character. Full-bodied with delicious nuances of fruits and mineral.
- 105. Chalk Hill 2014** **\$52.00**  
Chardonnay characterized by delicate hints of vanilla and toasted wood, great balance, smoothness, and a good quality of extracts, with a complex, robust structure supported by good acidity, and a scent of ripe exotic fruit.
- 106. Greco di Tufo Benito Ferrara Vigna Cicogna DOCG 2012** **\$60.00**  
This is one of the best Vigna Cicognas in years. Bright and fresh, rich mouth coating, very long finish and complex nose.

flavors. Medium bodied with a nice smooth finish.

Floral aroma with honeysuckle and almond flavor on the palate. Full silky, mouth and a lovely long finish.
- 115. Giorgio Cichero La Slina Gavi 2014** **\$40.00**  
A fragrant, complex aroma of apples, citrus, stone, and lillies. Green apple notes with good minerality on the palate. A crisp and clean medium-bodied and full of flavor wine.
- 116. Gavi di Gavi Deltetto 2012** **\$52.00**  
100% Cortese. The famous ancient grape grown among the town of Gavi in Southern Piedmont. The wine is fresh and clean with a floral fruity aroma and a dry mineral edge.
- 117. Fontaleoni Vernaccia di San Gimignano 2013** **\$38.00**  
Floral and fruity on the nose yet dry on the palate with refreshing acidity. Fine match with olives, seafood and white meats.
- 118. Querciabella Batar IGT Toscana 2010** **\$120.00**  
50% Pinot Bianco 50% Chardonnay. Endowed with layers of sweet fruit interwoven with mineral and sweet toasted oak, it offers outstanding length on the palate with notes of peaches and tropical fruit.
- 119. Puligny-Montrachet Carillion, First Cru Les Combettes 2011** **\$195.00**  
Vibrant nectarine and floral notes with fresh acidity. A light to medium weight white with delicate flavors. Enjoy fairly young.

Blend of 70% Cabernet Sauvignon and 30% Cabernet Franc, is full bodied with great balance. Deep intense color, Black Currants, cassis and cherries.
- 202. Di Majo Norante Ramitello Rosso DOC 2011** **\$46.00**  
This medium-bodied blend of 80% Montepulciano and 20% Aglianico grapes offers lots of depth of flavour in the glass. Big and rich Italian red wine with

generous layers of dark plums and smoke notes and mocha.

- 209. Fay "La Faya" Valtellina IGT 2011** **\$78.00**  
From a single terraced vineyard high in the Alps, a blend of 60% nebbiolo, 25% merlot and 15% syrah. Rich and complex showing the elegance of nebbiolo. Scented with a subtle aroma of spice, dark berries and plum; full and firm on the palate with generous fruit and balanced finish.

Estate grown blend of Corvina 50%, Rondinella 10%, Molinara 5%, Croatina 5% from the Le Quare vineyard. Smokey and sophisticated Amarone from Gamba that opens up with tones of black cherry, leather pipe tobacco, and dark chocolate.

- 212. Begali Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2011** **\$85.00**  
 A unique wine due to its origin, ancient grape variety and production method. Smooth from the beginning to the end, with unbelievable body.
- 213. Barbera D'Alba Andrea Oberto 2014** **\$52.00**  
 A single vineyard wine aged in small barrique with deep berry and black cherry flavors, intense bouquet and long finish.
- 214. Marchesi Di Gresi Barbera D'Asti 2013** **\$48.00**

"The Barolo of Southern Italy". Big, bold and muscular, with flavors of black fruits and berries and aromas of cigar box, leather and roasted spices. Balanced, with layered complexity and a rich finish.
- 241. Antinori Tignanello, Toscano 2012** \$160.00  
The famous Sangiovese Cabernet blend from Tuscany, intense ruby red with aromas of cloves and blueberries with hints of chocolate and plum on the finish.
